

Assembly instructions for: **SONOMA FINIAL PLANTERS**



Assembly Instructions

Thank you for purchasing Forever Redwood patio furniture. Forever Redwood is built by Old-Growth Again Restoration Forestry (OGA). OGA is dedicated to restoration forestry. Sales of patio furniture finance our restoration work in California redwood forestlands.

TOOLS REQUIRED: ½-inch ratchet and a mallet or small hammer.

- Your Planter Box was partially disassembled into Photo A & B.
- Your furniture was fully assembled in the shop prior to being dismantled for shipping. All the parts fit.
- The parts that go together have the same numbers written next to the predrilled holes they attach to.
- Please take the time to align the parts with the numbers.
- If you are forcing a bolt in, the part may be turned around or not aligned properly.
- Tap the bolt all the way into the wood to set the bolt. This assures that the bolt will not spin when you tighten it. Add a washer and lightly tighten. Do not over-tighten or you'll crush the wood and weaken your furniture's structural strength.

1. Attach one long side to the bottom. On each end, lightly tap a carriage bolt through the predrilled holes from the outside through the block in the planter bottom corner as shown. Tap the bolt head to set it into the wood. Insert washer and nut and tighten with a ½-inch ratchet. Do not over-tighten or you'll crush the redwood and weaken the planter's structure.



2. Attach other long side repeating steps in step 1.



3. Attach ends to planter sides with two carriage bolts. Remember to match up the numbers to each corresponding side. Align the predrilled holes, tap the bolts in, then add washers and nuts and tighten. The bolts should tap into their holes. If you have to force a bolt check your alignment. Repeat the step for other end.
