Assembly Instructions for: **TRELLISES FOR PLANTERS**

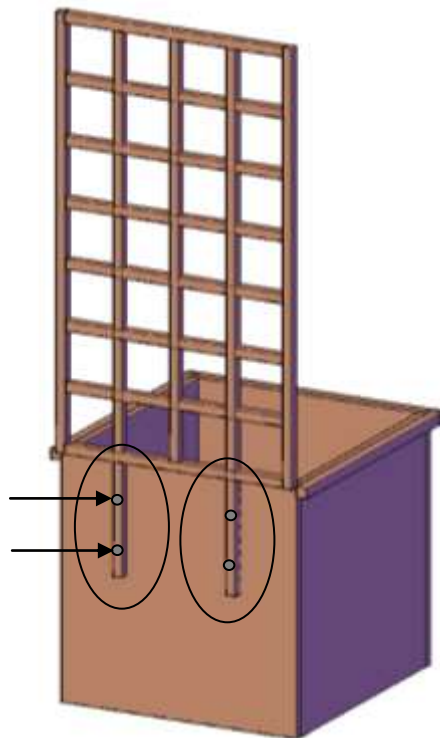
Tools required: ½-inch ratchet and a mallet or small hammer.

Box Content:

Quantity	Description	Drawing
1	Trellis	
4	2 ½" x 5/16" Carriage Bolts, washers and nuts	

The trellis frames attach to the rear of the planter wall with strong stainless steel carriage bolts in four places. The frame of the trellis is 2" x 2" thick and extends to just above the bottom of the planter (you will be asked to select how tall your planter is so we can adjust the frame accordingly).

Step 1: Unpack your trellis and make sure you have all the parts. Attach trellis to planter. Align the pre-drilled holes on trellis extensions with holes on planter wall and attach them with two carriage bolt (2 ½" x 5/16" Bolts) per side. Tap the carriage bolts all the way into the wood and through both the trellis and planter wall. Then insert the washers and nuts from the interior wall of the planter and tighten with a ½-inch ratchet. Do not over tighten or you'll crush the redwood and weaken the chair's structure.
